

PERSON

✗ *NOT just actual names, but also groups / types*




PERSON

✗ NOT just actual names, but also groups / types




PLACE

✖ *Can be locations, places, and regions*



THING

✗ Nouns, Adjectives, Verbs, Adverbs



✖Artifact

- + Any object made by human beings
- + *But also, natural objects changed by humans*
 - ✖ Tools, toys, clothing, pieces of buildings, etc.
 - ✖ *So... is a fossil an artifact?*



TIME

- ✖ When?
- ✖ Long or short time period?
- ✖ What things were before or after?



CAUSE

- ✖ Why did it happen?
- ✖ What other things led to it?



SIGNIFICANCE / SO WHAT?

- ✖ Who cares?
- ✖ What did they / it change?
