COMMON CHARACTERISTICS OF VILLAINS

- The capacity for evil and a willingness to do bad things
- A backstory that explains their villainous behavior
- A complex range of emotions
- A point of view that justifies their evil actions
- A special skill that sets them apart



Darth Vader

- Luke Skywalker's enemy and his father
- Evil and powerful
- Strong command over the Dark Side
- Excellent with a lightsaber
- Very good at killing his most of his enemies



- Spiderman's enemy
- Superhuman strength
- Weapons include: pumpkin bombs, gas bats and a glider
- Very agile, nimble and crafty
- In MCU has inner "voice" and is conflicted



Green Goblin



- Batman's enemy
- Criminal mastermind
- Evil clown
- Aims to cause as much misery and destruction as possible in Gotham
- Not to be trusted
- On several occasions chooses *not* to kill Batman

The Joker





- Superman's enemy
- Zod is a warlord from Superman's home planet of Krypton
- Has two evil sidekicks: Non and Ursa
- As powerful as Superman!
- Wants to take over the world

General Zod



Prince Hans Westerguard

- Dishonest, selfish and deceitful
- Left Anna to die
- Wants to kill Queen Elsa
- Excellent swordsmanship



- Imprisoned Rapunzel in a tower
- Selfish, cunning and uncaring
- Wants to remain young and beautiful forever – at whatever cost
- Has a dagger
- Tries to kill Eugene/Flynn
